- Review and report on learning interventions.

ASSESSMENT

After the training, you will be required to complete a Portfolio of Evidence to assess that you fully understand the education context in SA.

Who should apply?

Applicants must be:

- In possession of a grade 12, or equivalent qualification;
- Committed to attend all the training days and be fully committed to participate in the process;
- Having some experience in the After School, Child and Youth Development, or Education sectors and currently working with school learners as their primary beneficiaries; and
- Willing to use the skills and knowledge to support learners in under-resourced communities.

Course costs

The cost of this course is valued at R3,500.00. However, we offer scholarships to needy applicants who are providing academic and career support to learners, especially for grades 9-12 learners.
