TRAINING OUTCOMES	

This non-accredited one-day workshop will enable practitioners to conduct and facilitate career guidance sessions with grades 9-12 learners to prepare them for post-matric opportunities and future careers. The workshop will enable individuals to plan and facilitate ten two-hour career guidance workshops for learners. It provides step-by-step facilitation plans for each of the ten sessions, which could be adapted to suit available timeframes and the particular grade group that is targeted.

More specifically, after completion of the course, delegates will be able to:

- Conduct career guidance sessions with grades 9-12 learners;
- Introduce major themes and information regarding post-school opportunities;
- Offer facilitation plans and materials to run learner-centred career guidance activities; and
- Share targeted career guidance resources and services to support grades 9-12 learners' to make apt choices for their futures.

## **ASSESSMENT**

There is no assessment after the training, but it is possible to arrange for summative assessment.

## Who should apply?

Education, Training & Development Practitioners | ABET Facilitators | Community Workers

## Applicants must be:

- In possession of a grade 12, or equivalent qualification;
- Committed to attend all the training days and be fully committed to participate in the process;
- Having some experience in the After School, Child and Youth Development, or Education sectors and currently working with school learners as their primary beneficiaries; and
- Willing to use the skills and knowledge to support learners in under-resourced communities.

## **Course costs**

The cost of this course is valued at R2,000.00, but we offer scholarships to needy applicants who are providing academic and career support to learners, especially for grades 9-12 learners.
