<p>Applicants must be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ In possession of a grade 12, or equivalent qualification;</li> <li>❖ Committed to attend all the training days and be fully committed to participate in the process;</li> <li>❖ Having some experience in the After School, Child and Youth Development, or Education sectors and currently working with school learners as their primary beneficiaries; and</li> <li>❖ Willing to use the skills and knowledge to support learners in under-resourced communities.</li> </ul>
