- Oversee all aspects of the model implementation, including administrative and data-capturing.
- Oversee regions' data collection and compile reports both narrative and financial.
- Actively participate in setting up of branches in the region and ensuring branch targets are reached.
- Strategic analysis of branch needs year on year, based on growth plans.
- Schedule and write funder reports (including the financial report) as guided by the Fundraising team.

- Work together with the Programme Manager to develop the regional budget in accordance with the allocated regional income.
